

No open fires permitted

Barbeques must be supervised at all times ad fully extinguished before leaving site



Dogs must be controlled

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times unless safely confined to the allocated plot.



Park courteously

Park courteously and leave enough room for other members (Remember to close and lock the gate!)



Children must be supervised

Children must be supervised at all times whilst on site and not allowed to enter other plots.



Litter must be taken home

All litter must be removed from site and taken home for recycling or disposal.



Weeds and grass must be controlled

Weeds must not be allowed to grow on or around plots and areas of grass must be maintained.

This includes the area of grass pathway up to the half way point outside your plot.




No trees or deep rooting shrubs

Unfortunately, trees and deep rooting shrubs cannot be planted on allotment plots.



Conserve water

Use the communal water source sparingly and collect rainwater from your own plot where possible.



Avoid harsh chemicals

Protect the environment by avoiding harsh chemical fertilisers and pesticides.
